UNIFORM POLICY

PURPOSE

- To create a sense of collective and individual pride in Seaford Primary students and their identification with our school.
- To assist in individual student safety and group security when travelling to and from school and on excursions.
- To promote active and safe participation in school life.

GOALS

- The Seaford Primary Dress Code neither discriminates directly or indirectly against students on the basis of their gender, race, ethnic group, nationality, religious beliefs, colour, disability or socio economic circumstances.
- That the dress code will apply to all students while travelling to and from school, whilst at school and when students are engaged in school activities out of school hours.

IMPLEMENTATION

- The dress code will apply uniformly across all students except if an aspect of the code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of his or her ethnic cultural background, an aspect of the code prevents students with disabilities from being able to attend school or participate in school activities on the same terms as other students, a student has a particular health condition that requires departure from an aspect of the code, or if the student or the parents can demonstrate temporary economic hardship that prevents compliance with the code.
- When attending sporting activities, excursions and other designated school activities children will be required to wear the appropriate school uniform.
- Parents will have the option of purchasing items of school uniform from any supplier as long as the garments are similar style and are bottle green and gold.
- A sun smart hat must be worn in terms 1 and 4 during sporting activities, recess and lunch times, outdoor excursions etc.
- Children will not be withdrawn from the classroom because of any infringement of the dress code. However, the issue will be discussed with the student and his or her parent will be notified of the infringement. If this infringement continues, the student's parents will be asked to attend the school to discuss the concern with the Principal.
- The School Council Uniform Sub Committee will oversee the Uniform Shop.

EVALUATION

This policy will be reviewed as part of the Strategic Plan cycle. (Approved Nov 09)

UNIFORM:

Long or short sleeved gold polo shirt with or without school logo

Bottle green shorts, pants, track suit pants

Seaford Primary School dress

Bottle green skort or skirt (not netball skirt)

Bottle green windcheater, zip front jacket - with or without logo

Bottle green Sun Smart hat

School bag – of a size to fit lunch box, communication folder, jacket

Footwear – no open toed footwear. Sneakers, black or brown school shoes

Black Leggings (plain with no embellishments) – winter time – years prep - 5 under dress/skirt - not to be worn as an item by themselves.

Bottle green bike shorts under dresses or with t-shirts in summer.

Headbands, scrunchies and socks – green, gold, black, or white.

No makeup. No visible temporary tattoos or transfers.

Basic jewellery only ie sleepers or studs in ears.

YEAR 6 ONLY:

Black polo shirts and jacket with Year 6 design and school logo.

Black or green pants, leggings or shorts.

Inter School Sport yrs 5/6:

Seaford Sports t-shirt with green or black shorts or leggings.
